

**BOX ELDER COUNTY
2022 PRIMARY ELECTION**

The Board of Canvassers of Box Elder County, Utah, met at the County Courthouse, 01 South Main Street, Brigham City, Utah at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 12, 2022 to conduct a canvass of returns from the 2022 Box Elder County Primary Election pursuant to Utah Code Unannotated 20A-4-304. The following members were present constituting a quorum:

Clerk Marla R. Young conducted the canvass. A cursory review of the ballot tabulations was made. The results of the canvass are attached.

Ms. Young stated there were 10,156 ballots cast. The number of ballots cast by mail was 9768 and the number of ballots cast in person was 388. Seven by-mail ballots were received after Tuesday, June 28, which were timely post marked. One hundred six by-mail ballots were postmarked on or after June 28, and not counted. The 106 uncounted ballots were sealed in an envelope and filed with the 2022 Primary Election results. The number of ballots counted on election night was 8610 for an election night percentage of 43.74.

There were 17 voted provisional ballots counted and 15 not counted (Provisional Ballot Report attached). After counting the valid by-mail, in person and provisional ballots, the percentage of ballots counted was 51.59 percent, a total of 10,156 ballots. The 15 provisional ballots, which were not counted, were sealed in an envelope and filed with the 2022 Primary Election results.

Ms. Young reviewed the audit procedures with the Board. She said Box Elder County was required to audit 100 ballots and 98 signatures, which were randomly selected by the Lt. Governor. The 100 ballots selected were compared with Cast Vote Record in Electionware. She reported that the votes matched. The 98 voter signatures selected were compared with the signatures on file in Vista. She reported that the signatures matched.

Election Official, Marla R. Young, followed all of the noticing and reporting required by Utah State Code.

MOTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Summers to accept the results of the 2022 Primary Election as submitted by the Clerk-Election Official. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hadfield and unanimously carried.



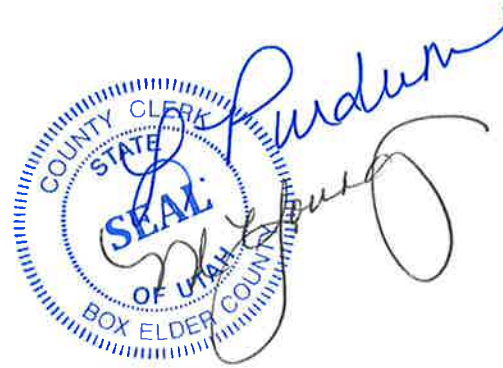
